BATTERIES

DOT Regulations require batteries be sorted and packaged by internal chemistry (alkaline, lead acid, Ni-Cad, etc). Most batteries must be packaged to prevent contact between terminals. All batteries must be packaged in DOT approved containers with the terminals protected from damage

ELECTRONICS



PCB BALLASTS

PCB ballasts must be packaged in UN-rated containers. The weight rating on individual containers may prevent you from completely filling each container.

Non-PCB ballasts must be packaged in a sealed sturdy container.



FLUORESCENT LAMPS

DOT Approved corrugated boxes, or returnable fiberboard drums



NO OPEN BOXES OR BOXES WITH LAMPS HANGING OUT. DO NOT TAPE LAMPS.



Sealed leak-proof poly container or sealed PVC tubing with packing material.



MERCURY DEVICES

NO BOXES, JARS, BAGS OR NON-APPROVED CONTAINERS



THIS UN RATING IS REQUIRED ON ALL BATTERIES, PCB WASTE, MERCURY WASTE AND OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE
